Why change?	WGL provides a consistent interior look without the mineral streaks and other wood characteristics found with NWV and WGV. The product also offers a dependable supply given anticipated issues with plywood stock.
What is Woodgrain Laminate (WGL)?	WGL consists of 45-gram resin reinforced paper (natural maple pattern), with a 6-mil UV urethane top coat. It is also referred to as a decorative foil. This material is applied using a hot-rolled glue lamination process.
How does it compare to Natural Wood Veneer (NWV) and Wood Grain Vinyl (WGV)?	This product uses the same substrate as NWV an WGV. Like NWV and WGV, this material passes KCMA/ANSI standards for heat, cold and chemical resistance.
Does WGL look different than NWV/WGV?	Yes. The printed laminate provides a more consistent look and color.
Is there a price increase with the new material?	There is a lot of uncertainty in the market but we believe this will help avoid specific price increases on these products.
Will my order contain a mix of any of these materials?	No.
What material will I get for warranty purposes if I have NWV or WGV?	Warranty and replacement items for orders placed before the change will be available until materials are depleted.
Is this product free of added urea formaldehyde?	Yes. The lamination process contains no added urea formaldehyde and the substrate core meets Carb 2 certification.
Is this product made in the U.S.?	The lamination process is done in the U.S. with materials from other countries. WGL is supplied by the same vendor as NWV and WGV.
